Guidelines for Abstract Submission

- 1. Abstracts must be sent to posterngaa@gmail.com before 31st August 2025.
- 2. Abstract should not be more than 250 words. The abstract structure should include the introduction, methods, results, and conclusions in running text without headings.
- 3. Abstract should include the title, authors, and contact details of corresponding author.
- 4. Use Arial font/Times New Roman size 12 with single line spacing for whole abstract including title and authors details.
- 5. Title should be formatted bold and names of all authors beneath it along with Email id of corresponding author.
- 6. All abstracts should be submitted and presented in clear, publication-ready English with accurate grammar and spelling.
- 7. The submitting author must ensure that all co-authors are aware of the contents of the abstract.
- 8. Abstracts will be selected after review by the technical committee and you will be notified of the acceptance of a poster presentation to the email through which poster was submitted.
- 9. Abstracts that adhere to the provided format will be considered for review.

Guidelines for poster preparation

- 1. A display area of 3 feet (Width) x 4 feet (Height) will be provided for each poster. Please ensure that your poster matches these dimensions.
- 2. The poster should include sections such as Title, Introduction, Methodology, Results, Conclusion, and Acknowledgements. Kindly use appropriate font size and type.
- 3. The names of authors, along with their affiliations, should be provided below the title, with an asterisk indicating the presenting author.
- 4. Only registered participants will be allowed to present posters. Each registered delegate can present a maximum of one poster.
