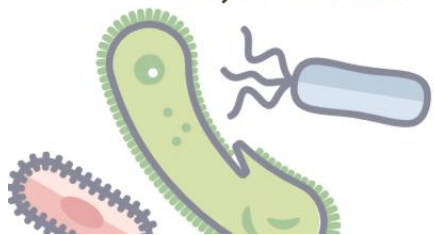


# About ICAR-NDRI

## About the Training

To ensure the availability of safe and quality dairy foods in accordance with Codex principles, the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) has established microbiological standards for milk and milk products under the Food Safety and Standards Regulations (FSSR), 2016. **Strengthening the capacity of food inspectors, laboratory personnel, researchers, students, and dairy industry professionals is essential for effective implementation of these standards.**

In this context, ICAR-NDRI, Karnal, is organizing a specialized 6-day training programme on **“Microbiological Evaluation of Hygiene and Safety in Milk and Milk Products.”** The programme will provide comprehensive theoretical and hands-on training on IS/ISO-based microbiological methods for assessing hygiene and safety indicators in dairy products.

**Participants will gain practical experience in pathogen detection, enumeration techniques, FSSR microbiological criteria, sampling plans, aseptic practices, biosafety concepts, and rapid diagnostic methods developed by ICAR-NDRI.**
